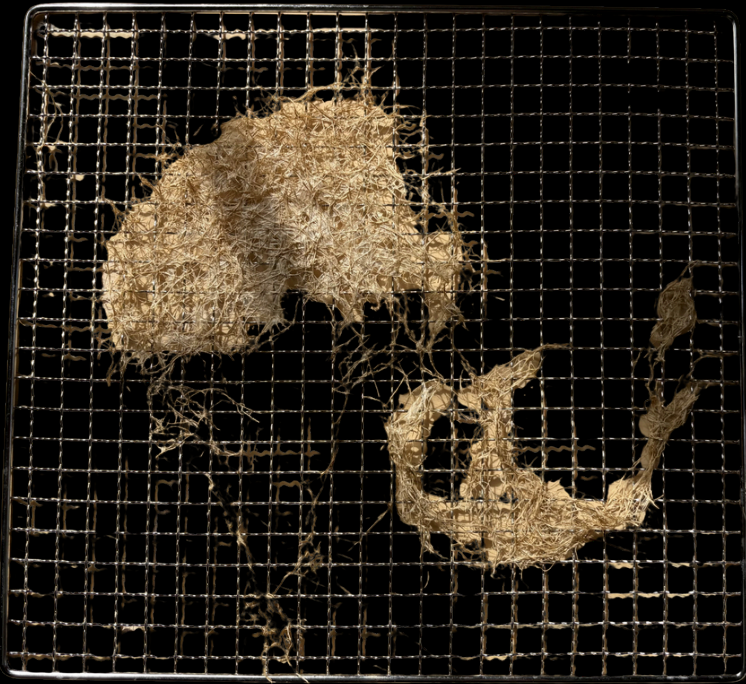

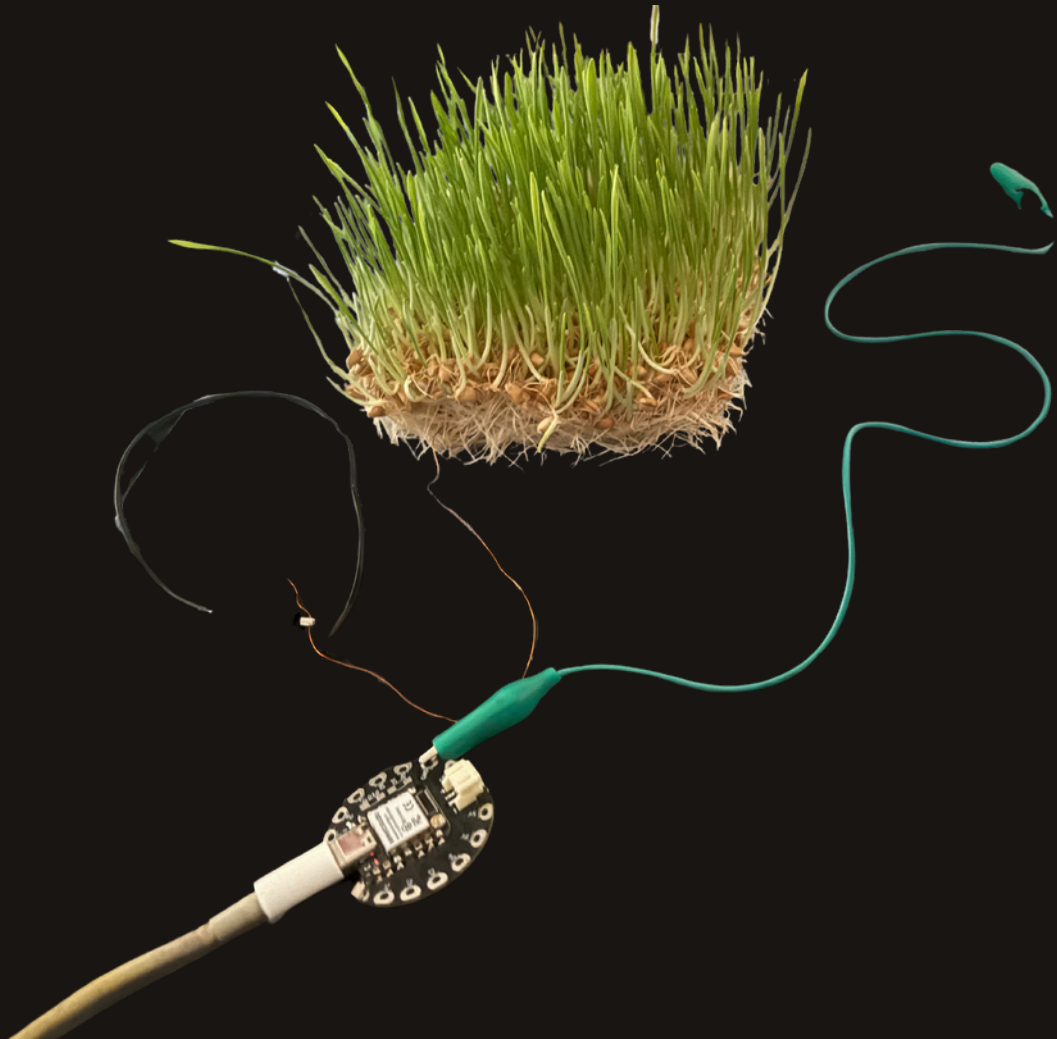

Devils tongue → Konnyaku

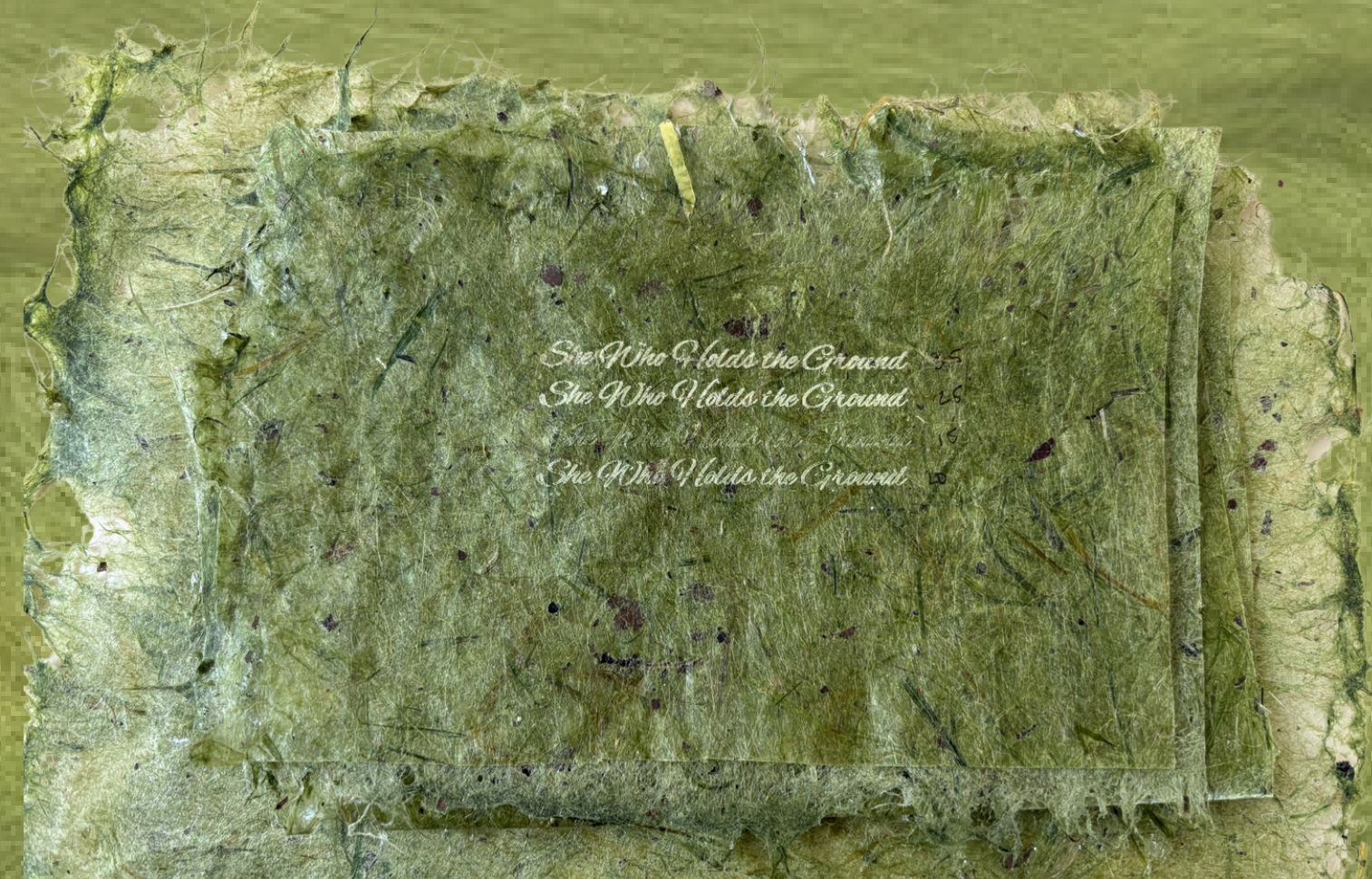
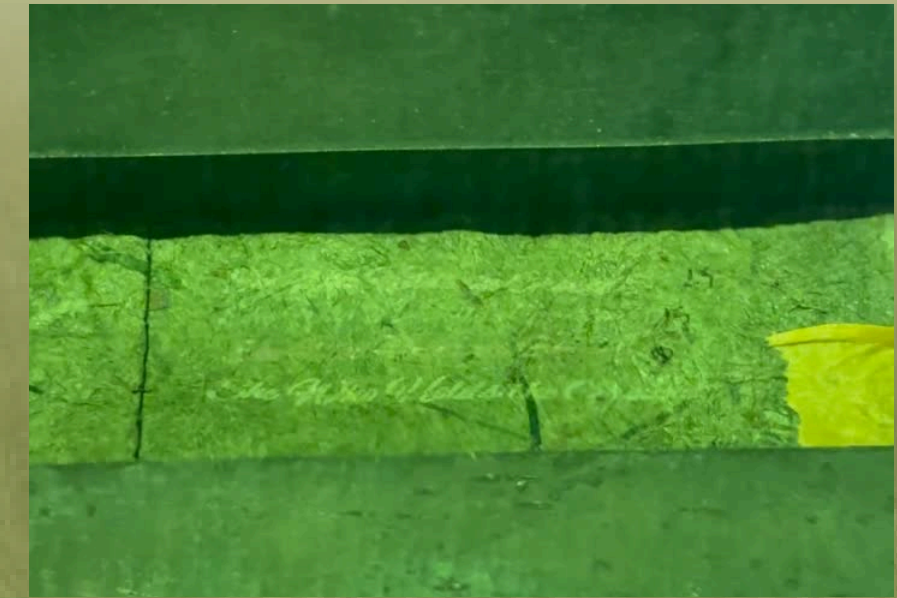
